COMMUNITY EVALUATION OF THE XXIII GENERAL CHAPTER

A few weeks ago, we finished our Chapter year in which we participated actively and co-responsibly. We have walked together through the different phases, praying and working, sharing with lay women and men, living a rich experience that has been, for all of us, a grace of God that has strengthened us.

We are now invited to remember what we have lived, personally and as a community, to gather the fruits of the process and present them as an offering to the Lord, who continues to call us for this new congregational moment.

We are aware that, from chapter to chapter, our personal and congregational adherence to Jesus in Nazareth, taking into account our richness and poverty, continues to encourage us to dream of new seeds strewn for the sowing, with new possibilities.

It is time to continue disposing ourselves to the creativity of the holy Ruah, listening to her criteria and allowing her to make new our fidelity to the Lord who calls us. She will be the best help for us to reimagine, in synodality, new spaces for the Charism.

Steps to follow for the evaluation:

- We dispose ourselves as a community to evaluate the Chapter process, grateful for the passage of God in all the work done.
We read "The Cracked Vessel" (Annex 1).
- Look for a time of **prayer and personal reflection** and let ourselves be led by the Lord. He takes us to a quiet place, as He did with His disciples, there He listens to our experience and offers us to rest with Him and enjoy the serene encounter, where we recognize our deepest truth.
Text: **Mk 6:31-34**.
It may also help us to listen to the song: "Come with me" (CD: "Seek my face" by Aín Karem).

In this environment we ask ourselves:

1. What has been my experience of the Chapter process?

2. What do I value most in the process?

Positive aspects that stand out in each of the phases:

- . Contemplative look at the reality of religious life, the Church, the world and Mother Earth.
- . Contemplative look at life and mission.
- . Discernment of the Congregation's journey into the future and of its organization and leadership.
- . Reimagining and projecting the future in synodality with audacity and hope.

3. How I value the participation of the laity (formation in Appreciative Inquiry, summit, evaluation of life and mission, assemblies, opening and closing rites).

4. I rate from 1 to 5 (1 not very satisfied and 5 very satisfied):

- my degree of participation in the process
- the information received

I give reasons for my answers.

5. Suggestions for future chapters.

- Sharing in community

Each one shares the fruit of her reflection.

After listening to all of them, the community reaches a consensus and decides what wishes to share with the rest of the Congregation and posts it on the Padlet set up for this purpose. From there, the General Team will collect, synthesize and share it with the whole Congregation.
